



Biography Stéphane Cueille – Clean Sky Governing Board Chairman

Stéphane Cueille started his career with Snecma (now Safran Aircraft Engines) from 1998 à 2001, where he worked on ceramic matrix composites (CMC). He joined the French defense procurement agency DGA in 2001, taking various management positions in the aircraft propulsion sector. From 2005 to 2008 he was in charge of the Missiles-Space unit in the DGA's industrial affairs department (S2IE). In 2008, he returned to Snecma, starting at the turbine blade quality department at the Gennevilliers plant. He was subsequently named repair general manager in Snecma's Military Engine division, then director of the turbine blade center of excellence. In May 2013 he was appointed Managing Director of Aircelle Ltd, the British subsidiary of Aircelle (Safran Nacelles), based in Burnley. In January 2015, he was named director of the Group's R&T center, Safran Tech, then in July 2016, Safran Executive Vice President for R&T and Innovation.

Stéphane Cueille, 46, graduated from the École Polytechnique (1991), and holds a post-graduate degree in solid physics and a PhD in statistical physics (1998).
